EBL Division One Men	3	0

Pre-game checks/duties:

- Timing equipment
- Table equipment: Arrow, team foul markers, personal foul markers
- Table set up: Officials in correct order
- Scoreboard
- Sounding devices
- Substitute's chairs
- Table Official's meeting
- Information from officials: Licence numbers, duties i.e. referee/umpire, agreed half time



Assessing Table Officials.

Level 2

General:

- ★ Time of arrival
- ★ Uniform (Red & Black)
- ★ Pre-game duties/checks
- ★ Communication with co-officials
- ★ Signals to floor officials
- ★ End of game duties
- ★ Professionalism – e.g. *no* mobile phone use
no food on table

Scorer:

- ★ Scorebook
- ★ Substitutions
- ★ Charged Timeouts
- ★ Foul(s) administration
- ★ ¼, ½ and full time duties
- ★ Possession Arrow
- ★ Extra Period(s)

Timekeeper:

- ★ Game Clock operation
- ★ Timeout clock
- ★ Pre-game, ¼, ½ and full game-clock duties
- ★ Last 2 minutes stopping clock
- ★ Extra Period(s)

Level 3

Where possible an ABBTO approved assessor should also be in attendance.

General, Scorer,

Timekeeper:

- ★ As for Level 2.

Shot Clock Operator:

- ★ Pre-game checks
- ★ Application of rule
- ★ Last 10 second communication

PLEASE:

Don't sign an assessment sheet unless you were asked to assess the candidate **PRIOR** to the start of that game.

Don't sign an assessment sheet unless you are happy with the candidate's performance.

If you are dissatisfied - tell them why and encourage them to try again on another occasion.
