

TABLE OFFICIALS REMINDERS

SHOT- CLOCK

1. Table Officials are reminded of the 24 seconds (shot clock) rules / mechanics. The sounding of the shot clock buzzer whilst the ball is in the air **DOES NOT** stop the game clock. If the team in control of the ball fails to shoot for goal within 24 seconds, the sounding of a loud signal shall indicate this to inform the floor officials that the 24 seconds has expired. **ONLY** a whistle from the floor officials stops the game clock.
 2. If the signal is sounded and the ball is in flight on a shot for goal, then the goal, **if made**, will count. If the ball touches the ring but does not enter the basket, the signal is disregarded and the game continues. If the ball misses the ring a violation has occurred **unless** the opponents gain immediate and clear control of the ball, in which case the signal will be disregarded and the game will continue.
 3. When the ball comes into play from out of bounds following a successful basket the 24 Seconds Operator must be careful to ensure that the 24-seconds period does not start until a player on court has gained control of the ball.

THE LAST 2 MINUTES OF THE 4TH QUARTER OR EXTRA PERIOD (S)

SUBSTITUTIONS

- In the last two minutes of the fourth (4th) period or the last two minutes of each period of extra time, substitution is permitted to **the non-scoring team**

TIME-OUT

- If a field goal is scored, a time out request may be administered **to the non-scoring team**

GENERAL SCORESHEET REMINDERS FROM NATIONAL ASSESSMENT

1. Do finish ruling off the scoresheet neatly, **do not draw zig zag lines** on your scoresheet.
 2. Do draw **a Single Line**
 - a) Under the 1st, 2nd & 3rd Quarter Scores
 - b) Through unused player & coach foul columns at the end of the game
 - c) Through unused extra timeouts at the end of the game
 3. Do draw **a Double Line** under
 - a) The Final Score (this will be the end of extra periods if played)
 - b) And through any unused Time-Outs.
 4. Draw **a Single Line** through any unused space on the Team List Section.
 5. Take a pride in your score sheet
